

General Medical School Exam Arrangements

- Familiarise yourself with the University's exam regulations.
- Seating plans will be emailed to you in advance.
- Know your exam **room** and **desk number**.
- Arrive 30 minutes before the start time and wait in the designated area.
You will be taken to the exam room about 15 minutes before the start for the briefing.
- Once inside the exam room, remain silent until the exam begins.
- Bring your **UID** and place it on your desk; it will be checked twice.
- A pencil will be provided—do **not** bring pens or a pencil case.
- Plain note paper will be provided and must **not** be removed from the room.
- You may bring a **clear, label-free water bottle**.
- No food is allowed.
- Leave belongings in the designated (unsupervised) area.
- Your device must be exam-ready, with the exam pre-downloaded and fully charged. You may bring a charger, power pack, cable, or extension lead, but all setup must be completed before the exam starts.
- Late entry is at the **chief invigilator's discretion**. Entry is not permitted in the first 15 minutes, and no extra time will be given.
- Early departure is allowed except in the **first or last 15 minutes**.
- You may request to use the bathroom; an invigilator will accompany you, and you consent to checks for unauthorised materials.
- At the end of the exam, remain silent until all green screens are confirmed by the invigilator.
- Leave quietly to avoid disturbing others.
